**Distance:** B and C – approx 4.4 mls; E, D and D2 – approx 3.5 mls;

Juniors – 1.0 to 1.5 miles approx.

**Draw:** Sat – Random Draw / Sun - seeded

**Amenities:** Stone-built toilets with water supply at the lake. Cafe and toilets at Visitor Centre in Low Dalby, catering van at rally site if numbers allow. Plenty of parking space around the Start Area – you can stake your dogs on the verges.

**Trails:** Based on the edge of a plateau in the centre of the forest, the course is relatively flat with several short climbs and descents. Surface is grass trails and fine chalk powdered crush, which can be abrasive especially if frozen, so some dogs may need booting.

**Camping:** On site camping may be available in the forest for a small charge, please contact the Rally Organisers for details.

**Directions:** Take the A64 from the A1 towards Malton. At Malton turn left to Pickering on A169. At roundabout in Pickering (Rally signs start here) turn right onto A170 to Thornton-le-Dale. As you drop down the hill into Thornton, turn left towards Whitby (signed Dalby Forest). After approx one mile, turn right into Dalby Forest and downhill to Low Dalby Village. Follow signs to venue.

**Notes:** Please fill any holes your dogs dig, pick up litter and dog mess and remember your trail etiquette ... be nice to everyone you meet and enjoy your run !
